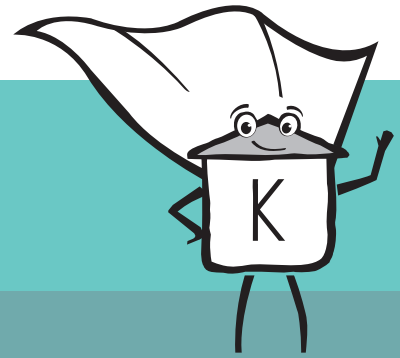

Digital Citizenship Week is **October 14–18, 2019**. Celebrate, renew, or activate your school's commitment to digital citizenship by participating with this free activity.

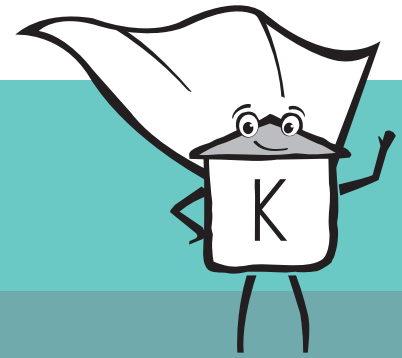
How?
