


B. Resist Temptation

Get Set for School is comprised of hands-on learning through play with positive transitions between activities in order to keep children engaged and participating throughout the school day. Unit 1 focuses on behavior and the skills children need to be successful at school. This includes, but is not limited to greetings, understanding who are friends, friendly behavior, similarities and differences between people, how to look and listen, polite and rude behavior, manners and respect, sharing with others, taking turns, waiting for turn or in line, etc. From the beginning, we establish what is appropriate for behavior at school, discuss those things, make class lists, and/or experience them through dramatic play. In Units 2–6, children continue to practice appropriate behaviors throughout in preparation for kindergarten.

The Get Set for School classroom structure and activities are designed to support the development of self-concept, self-regulation, personal initiative, emotional understanding, and relationships with adults and peers while children are learning. Children will transition appropriately, take initiative, understand feelings, and take turns sharing and playing with their friends. Children need to feel safe and accepted and have reassurance in the classroom environment. Children need support with social and emotional development to build strong social and emotional skills.

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A. Demonstrates the Ability to Postpone Activity and Start Another

Understanding & complying with classroom rules, routines, & expectations.

- Takes and gives cues to other children during transition and models their appropriate behavior with adult support
- 2. Occasionally demonstrates the ability to stop an engaging activity to help clean up with and requiring less support and guidance from an adult.

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B. Demonstrates the Ability to Adapt to New Environment with Appropriate Behaviors with Adult Support

- Manages separation anxiety from home to school by kissing caregiver goodbye waving from the window every day.
- 2. Frequently demonstrates comfort with the transition from home to the classroom environment (e.g., easily calms down when parents leave).
- Engages in out of the classroom activities (i.e., recess) and successfully re- enters classroom without disruption

Throughout the Get Set for School Pre-K curriculum, teachers are frequently prompting and carefully scaffolding children as they arrive at their own answers and responses. Children learn by watching, imitating, and then independently doing. Each lesson is structured this way with teachers consistently supporting students in their responses and decisions. Communication and engaging discussions between teachers, children, and their peers is encouraged throughout all learning areas.
